Targeting Life Skills



The **Targeting Life Skills (TLS)** Model provides a simplified method of coordinating lesson objectives and life skills. Utilizing the 4-H clover (which represents Hands, Heart, Health and Head), the TLS Model helps identify the indicators of change essential for effective evaluation.
