

## **ADULT VOLUNTEER LEADERS JUDGE DISTRICT 4-H JOURNALS**

- WHERE:** C. A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center, Ferndale, Ark.
- WHEN:** Mid-to-late February – Check 4-H Outlook for exact date.
- WHY:** Provide volunteer leaders the opportunity to give input into 4-H Journal judging, and to provide training experiences in 4-H record keeping.
- WHO:** A total of 12 volunteer leaders will be selected to serve as members of the Beginning and Intermediate Journal judging committees. A county may nominate any number of adult volunteers to serve on the committee. Applicants should complete the “Adult Leader’s Application for 4-H Journal Judging.”
- REQUIREMENTS:** Volunteers will participate in the three-day judging activity and will be housed at the C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center. Background and experience in 4-H Journals would be beneficial. Volunteers will serve as members of subcommittees with Extension professionals and will judge Journals from one Extension district.
- EXPENSES:** Expenses including meals and lodging for the three-day event will be \$145. There will be no charge to the volunteers selected. The Arkansas 4-H Foundation will pick up the cost.
- APPLICATIONS DUE:** Applications are due in the state 4-H office on February 1.
