WHO: Two adult volunteer 4-H leaders, age 25 or older

WHAT: Receive all-expense-paid trip to 4-H Congress

WHEN: Late November

WHERE: Hyatt Regency, Atlanta, Ga.

PROGRAM SPECIFICS:

The program is one of recognition for 4-H members who have achieved at the highest level and have been named state 4-H Journal winners. Members and leaders will be involved in a week of strenuous activities, including banquets, workshops and tours. 4-H Congress will focus on community solutions to issues facing youth.

LEADER'S ROLE:

The two volunteer leaders accompanying the Arkansas delegation will help coordinate the activities of group members. Congress is a trip where delegates are involved in most activities as a state delegation and workshops with others from across the nation. There will also be several major events when the delegation will want to participate as a state group.

APPLICATIONS:

Apply by completing the Arkansas Adult 4-H Leader Activity Application, FY4H-656, and returning it to your county Extension office. Applications are due in the state 4-H office March 1.
