

Arkansas State 4-H Adventure and Challenge Camp

Teen 4-H'ers will have the opportunity to enjoy three action-packed days of fun, adventure, education, and leadership with a lot of new friends from all over the state. Programs and theme will vary from year to year. Leadership development with the ExCEL Leadership Program, including high ropes course, is a part of the camp each year.

Goals and Objectives:

- Develop and strengthen the mental and physical skills of 4-H youth.
- Offer a challenge to 4-H campers to accomplish a high level of self-confidence, individual self-worth, personal growth, and achievement during camp.
- Strengthen interpersonal relationship skills of 4-H campers so as to become a functioning team member.
- Involve 4-H campers in a group-oriented experience.
- Develop leadership life skills in order that they become contributing members of society.
- Develop an appreciation for and respect of the outdoors.

WHO: Senior 4-H members (13-15 years old as of January 1) going into the 8th, 9th or 10th grades (must have completed 7th grade), adult volunteers, and county personnel

APPLICATION INFORMATION: Reservation forms indicating campers' names, choice of camp dates, T-shirt size, gender, and a \$25 per person non-refundable deposit will be required. This deposit will be due to the C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center in March (see 4-H Events Calendar for specific date). Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Applications and full payment are due to the C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center in June (see 4-H Events Calendar for specific date). A late fee of \$35/camper will be added to the fee of any late application or payment. There will be an informational packet sent to extension personnel via e-mail in January. Anyone interested in attending camp should contact their county extension office for more information and applications.
