

## Arkansas State 4-H Junior Camp

Arkansas 4-H State Junior Camps offer youth ages 9–12, adult volunteers, and county personnel, a unique educational camping experience at the C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center.

Staff at the C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center work with county and state faculty to plan the theme, workshops, and activities for the camp. The theme changes each year. Activities will vary between indoors and outdoors. The goal is to have fun, educational workshops that all fit the year's camp theme. The 4-H staff and a selected group of teen camp counselors then organize and conduct camp for participants.

**WHO:** Junior 4-H members (ages 9–12 by January 1) going into 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, or 7<sup>th</sup> grades, adult volunteers, and county personnel

**WHEN:** July

**WHERE:** C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center

**APPLICATION INFORMATION:** Reservation forms indicating campers' names, choice of camp dates, T-shirt size, gender, and a \$25 per person non-refundable deposit will be required. This deposit will be due to the C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center in March (see 4-H Events Calendar for specific date). Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Applications and full payment are due to the C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center in June (see 4-H Events Calendar for specific date). A late fee of \$35/camper will be added to the fee of any late application or payment. There will be an informational packet sent to extension personnel, via e-mail, in January. Anyone interested in attending camp should contact their county extension office for more information and applications.
