What: We strive to create a positive outdoor educational experience for learners of all ages through objective-driven, experience-based activities.

4-H Arkansas Outdoor School programs are offered as a one-day or two-day/one night experiential outdoor education field trip.

Our outdoor education program can be customized to meet your needs and is aligned to the Arkansas state educational frameworks. We offer program sessions related to wildlife, astronomy, forestry, nature awareness, canoeing, rock wall climbing, stream life, nature photography, wilderness survival and fishing, just to name a few.

Where: The Arkansas Outdoor School is based at the C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center in west Little Rock. Many programs can also be offered “on the road” at other outdoor facilities.

When: Year-round.

Why: It is our goal to help our participants connect to the natural world by taking them out of the classroom and into the outdoors. Through our experience-based activities, it is our intention to introduce participants to the 4-H leadership life skills as interpreted through our mission: Learning about the natural world, communication through teamwork, conservation of our natural resources, exploring relationships to and within nature, understanding self, and decision-making, particularly with regard to understanding the environmental impact of our choices.
