

## **S.E.E.K. INFORMATION**

**(4-H Science Enrichment Education for Kids)**

- WHO:** 1<sup>st</sup>–12<sup>th</sup> grade homeschoolers
- WHAT:** Science Enrichment Education for Kids, or **S.E.E.K.**, is a supplemental science program conducted by the 4-H RES-Q faculty.
- WHERE:** C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center in Ferndale (Pulaski County)
- WHEN:** Students meet one day a week for 12 weeks, beginning in the first week in December and ending in the first week in March.
- WHY:** The program is not intended to be an entire year's science curriculum. Instead, its purpose is to provide hands-on science experiences that the home school parent may not be able to provide due to time or money constraints. The 4-H Center facility provides forest, water and wildlife that may not be readily available to the home school parent. In addition, the students have microscopes and other equipment at their disposal.
- COST:** Tuition covers all materials for the entire 12 weeks. It is RES-Q's goal is to provide this program at a minimal cost to the parent. The cost is \$220 for the first child and \$205 for the second child. (Contact coordinator if enrolling more than two children.)
