

S.E.E.K. INFORMATION

(4-H Science Enrichment Education for Kids)

- WHO:** 1st–12th grade homeschoolers
- WHAT:** Science **E**nrichment **E**ducation for **K**ids, or **S.E.E.K.**, is a supplemental science program conducted by the 4-H Arkansas Outdoor School (AOS) faculty.
- WHERE:** C.A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center in Ferndale (Pulaski County)
- WHEN:** Students meet one day per week, for 12 weeks, beginning in late November and ending in early March.
- WHY:** SEEK's purpose is to provide hands-on, experiential learning in science, which may supplement what the parent is teaching at home. The 4-H Center property is a valuable natural resource and serves as an outdoor classroom. SEEK offers time for socialization and gives home-schooling families an opportunity for their children to learn in a fun, non-traditional classroom.
- COST:** Tuition covers all materials for the entire 12 weeks. One of the objectives of the Arkansas Outdoor School is to provide this program at a minimal cost to the parent. The tuition is \$235 for the first child and \$220 for the second child, with a multiple child discount offered.
