

CITIZENSHIP... WASHINGTON FOCUS PROGRAM

Arkansas will participate in the Citizenship...Washington Focus program to be held at the National 4-H Center in Washington, D.C. Applications with \$200 deposit are due to the state 4-H office November 1. The balance of payment is due January 15. Due dates will be enforced. Any application received past the due date will not be considered unless vacant slots exist. One delegation will go each summer.

Package trip fee will cover program costs while at the National 4-H Center, transportation, theater ticket for Cultural Heritage night, a personal copy of an 8x10 color picture of the delegation taken on Capitol Hill and a snack break during delegate orientation. We recommend that each 4-H'er bring at least \$150 of spending money.

Each county will be allotted at least one 4-H member to attend, as far as possible, provided the county recommends a member who is in either the 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade and who will be 14 years of age or older by January 1. **Delegates must meet these requirements.** The registration will be through arkansas.4honline.com.

4-H leaders who wish to be considered for selection should register through arkansas.4honline.com. We will need several nominations. All adults serving as leaders must be at least 25 years of age. The cost for 4-H volunteer leaders will be approximately half that of the delegate fee. A deposit of \$200 must be submitted with the application.

Polo shirts will be provided for all individuals attending Citizenship...Washington Focus. All delegates and leaders applying for the trips need to indicate the appropriate size on their application forms.

Refund Policy: NO REFUNDS AFTER DELEGATION IS MADE.

Delegates – Deposit of \$200 with application November 1; final payment due January 15.

Leaders –Deposit of \$200 with application November 1; final payment due January 15.
