

HALL OF FAME

OVERVIEW OF PROGRAM:

The Arkansas 4-H Hall of Fame originated to recognize truly outstanding 4-H Teen Stars who have achieved at the highest level and who have contributed to making Arkansas 4-H a dynamic and well-known organization.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

To be considered for the 4-H Hall of Fame, a 4-H member must:

1. Be an Arkansas 4-H Teen Star. **Note:** A 4-H member may be named an Arkansas 4-H Teen Star and inducted into the Arkansas 4-H Hall of Fame in the same year.
2. Be at least a high school senior at the time of nomination. 4-H'ers may be nominated two additional years after their last year of 4-H eligibility. This means that 4-H members who have had their 19th birthday in the current year end 4-H eligibility on December 31 but will be eligible for Hall of Fame nomination on April 1 of the following year and the next April 1.
3. Be an active 4-H member who has achieved at the highest level in the club, county, and state. National achievements are not a requirement but will be considered.
4. Be a 4-H member who has used personal 4-H accomplishments to help others achieve.
5. Be a 4-H member who has provided outstanding leadership to 4-H and made significant contribution to the 4-H program at the club, county, and state level.
6. Be a 4-H member who has shown a strong commitment to 4-H.
7. Be a 4-H member who has never been found in violation of the Arkansas 4-H Code of Conduct by the Review Board.
8. Be nominated by a county Extension faculty member using the Arkansas 4-H Hall of Fame Nomination Form (copy follows).

SELECTION PROCESS:

Nominations will be reviewed by a state committee, and interviews will be conducted if the selection committee feels this to be necessary. Nominations may be made annually; however, inductions into the Arkansas 4-H Hall of Fame may not be made each year. Inductions will be made only when truly outstanding nominations are received which fully meet the criteria for membership.

NOMINATION FORM:

The Arkansas 4-H Hall of Fame nomination form should be used by county Extension faculty to recommend outstanding 4-H members for the Hall of Fame. A copy of this form follows.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

New inductees into the Arkansas 4-H Hall of Fame will be announced and recognized at the Arkansas 4-H Teen Leader Conference.

Each inductee will receive a certificate denoting membership in the Arkansas 4-H Hall of Fame. A picture of each inductee will hang in the Arkansas 4-H Center.

DUE DATE: The Arkansas 4-H Hall of Fame Nomination Form (FY4-H-140) is due in the state 4-H office April 1 or first business day of April.
